DIAHANN CARROLL

October 1, 2009

Diahann Carroll is the consummate entertainment legend. From the Broadway stage to motion pictures and television, this versatile performer is a Tony Award Winner, an Emmy and Grammy nominee, an Oscar contender, and most recently a fashion designer. In 1968, Miss Carroll became the first black actress to star in her own NBC series, *Julia*. Diahann moved on to create the role of Dominique Deveraux in the nighttime phenomenon, *Dynasty*.

Diahann Carroll also is a breast cancer survivor and a strong advocate of women's health.

With more than 100 million copies of her books in print worldwide and her novels translated into 23 languages, Debbie Macomber is one of today's leading voices in romance and women's fiction. Debbie celebrated a new career milestone in September, 2007, when the seventh book in her Cedar Cove series, *74 Seaside Avenue*, scored #1 on the New York Times best seller list.

In 2008, Leisure Arts, publishers of the *Knitting Along With Debbie* pattern booklets, launched a complete line of Debbie Macomber knitting notions. All profits from the sale of the pattern booklets and knitting notions go to charity.

M. Gary Neuman is a Florida psychotherapist, rabbi and creator of the internationally recognized *Sandcastles Program* for children of divorce. He is also the author of several books, including, *Helping Your Kids Cope with Divorce the Sandcastles Way*, and *Emotional Infidelity: How to Affair-Proof Your Marriage and Other Secrets to a Great Marriage*.

Neuman's work has received national media coverage including multiple appearances on *Oprah*, *The Today Show*, *The View*, as well as appearances on *Dateline*, *NBC Nightly News*, *CBS Weekend News* and *Good Morning America*. He has also been written about in numerous publications including *People*, *Time*, *Cosmopolitan* and *Parents Magazine*.



JACKIE MAYER

May 20, 2010

Miss America 1963, Jackie Mayer, Miss Ohio, suffered a near – fatal stroke at age 28, bringing her Cinderella lifestyle to a standstill. Jackie began the challenge of relearning simple tasks that she had taught her 5-year old son, Bill, just months before. With Bill as her teacher, she learned the A-B-C's, how to tie her shoes, and how to laugh at her own mistakes.

Through the support of family and friends she began a seven year recovery process that brought back her motor functions, enabling her to walk, speak, and regain most of the day-to-day functionality the stroke so quickly took away.

Through her grace and compelling life story, Jackie dispels the myth that Miss America's live idyllic, fairy tale lives. Today she considers herself 90% recovered and uses each day to strive to reach 100%.

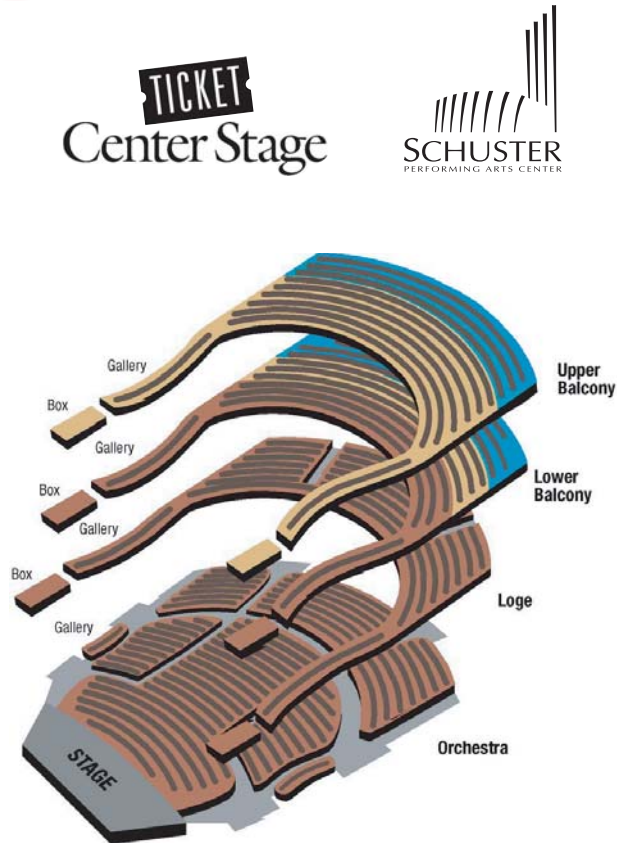
